

## **DISCOVER-AQ OUTLOOK - Sept. 8, 2013**

Generally easterly and southeasterly flow continued over the area today with scattered thunderstorms.

Tomorrow looks similar to today with scattered thunderstorms and considerable cloudiness. Ozone levels are still expected to be relatively low, although somewhat larger than over the weekend. Maxima expected to the west and northwest of Houston. Aerosol content still will remain relatively clean with considerable sea salt contribution in the southeastern portion of our region of interest.

A drying trend should be evident Tuesday and Wednesday with thunderstorms more confined to offshore and to the south and west of Houston. Considerable cloudiness still on Tuesday, but become less so on Wednesday. It appears that Wednesday will likely be a decent day to fly.

Looking farther ahead, conditions continue to improve Thursday and Friday as a ridge will extend from the upper Midwest down through Texas. Dry conditions with minimal cloudiness and storms are expected.
