

DISCOVER-AQ Outlook for Saturday, July 22, 2011

After three flight days in a row, we will not be flying tomorrow. If we were interested in flying tomorrow, it would promise to be another hot and polluted day, but with the risk of greater amount of cloudiness and greater risk of afternoon thunderstorms than today. Sunday appears to be the day with the greatest chance of showers (40%). A frontal zone will slip through on Monday afternoon, keeping cloudiness in the forecast. Tuesday has some promise of being clear enough to fly. Air quality will likely be at least code orange tomorrow, but more uncertain for Sunday with the increased cloudiness.
